## Introduction

Dear Parent/Carer or Guardian,

Thank you for taking in an interest in either **Waterside SEMH (Social Emotional Mental Health) Primary School** or **King's Oak SEMH Secondary School** including **Oak Lodge**.

Our admissions criteria is set by the Royal Borough of Greenwich as the only maintained specialist schools within the borough. Please check the documentation on our website so you can see the code of practice.

This policy, albeit short, is to enable you to see the routes to access the services offered by both schools and the federation as a whole.

## How do I apply for a place within the Imperium Federation?

Unlike other maintained schools within the Royal Borough of Greenwich, Waterside and King's Oak's admissions are undertaken via the SEND (Special Educational Needs Department) within the Greenwich.

Applications are discussed at a panel meeting (held regularly throughout the year - the schedule is available on request from SEND Greenwich) where all the evidence presented is scrutinised.

Regardless of whether your child attends a Greenwich school or a neighbouring borough, the process is the same. SEN Departments across all boroughs are aware of the consultation process and as such, all enquiries should be directed through them.



## What Criteria is used?

Waterside and King's Oak are both Social Emotional Mental Health (SEMH) schools. Oak Lodge is part of King's Oak and is a therapeutic offer for pupils who already have a placement within King's Oak.

Waterside has several other elements to its provision such as Nook for pupils with an ASD diagnosis primarily in Years 5 and 6 who have found either school or a school based DSP (Designated Specialist Provision) unsuitable for their needs ; Nurture - for pupils who have significant attainment difficulties.

King's Oak (in 2023) opened an additional provision called Oak Lodge, which offers a therapeutic academic bridging provision, so that pupils would transfer into King's Oak.

All pupils must have a diagnosis of SEMH on their application form as well as :

- up to date EHCP (Educational Health Care Plan) or be at the NA2 stage with agreement from the sending LA that it will be converted to a full EHCP
- Annual Review paperwork within the last 3 months
- Emergency Annual Review paperwork (if applicable) within the last month
- Full evidence of interventions undertaken by previous provisions
- Understanding from parent/carer/guardian of the type of school

If all agree, your son's paperwork will be sent to all agreed specialist schools and settings and they will consult on if they are able to (a) meet his needs and (b) have a space available.</b></p> <p><b>King's Oak will turn around a consultation well within the 15 day agreed period so that you as a parent/carer or guardian are fully aware of what we can or cannot offer.</b></p> <p><b>If your son is offered a placement with us, we will be in contact to arrange meetings with the Head of School, Head of Year and SENDCo so you are confident that we will do the very best to ensure your son leaves us with the qualifications he needs.</b></p> <p><b>Oak Lodge will be in discussion with the SEN department and King's Oak Head of School and Executive Head.
